## MINISTER OF YOUTH

Thank you for your interest in First Baptist Church of Silsbee, Texas. Silsbee is located at the edge of the Piney Woods region about fifteen miles northeast of the Port of Beaumont on the Texas Gulf coast. First Baptist Church's address is 350 HWY 96 S. Our city has a population of 6,600 people with a little over 54,000 residents in Hardin County.

First Baptist Church has a growing 1,000 plus members with 800 enrolled in Sunday school. We currently average 300 attendees in Sunday school and 350 attendees in Sundays worship services. Our church is a part of two organizations: The Southern Baptist Convention (SBC) and Southern Baptist of Texas Convention (SBTC).

It is our goal to have a youth minister that meets three important criteria: scriptural soundness, helping parents achieve their preeminent role in fulfilling their Biblical assignment, and undergirding the pastor as chief under-shepherd of the students as connected to the entire church body. The youth minister will be spiritually nurturing to middle and high school students. The youth minister will help return leadership to the parents for spiritual maturity and discipleship. The youth minister will attempt to involve all parents as an active part of the team of those providing spiritual training for the children. The youth minister will understand the current issues and challenges facing young people and families today. The youth minister will consistently and persistently share the gospel with parents and students.

### THE YOUTH MINISTER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

#### A. Youth Minister Responsibilities.

1. Develop, lead, and promote the overall youth ministry
2. Plan and coordinate outreach events
3. Involve Students as workers
4. Involve students as leaders
5. Locate and provide youth ministries resources

#### B. Ways to Assist the Pastor

6. Support the pastor, church, and church leaders
7. Review the teaching/discipleship plan and resources with the pastor
8. Connect the students to the pastor of the church

#### C. Ways to Assist the Parents

9. Equip and resource parents to disciple their children
10. Support the institution of the family
11. Connect parents to the church
12. Provide ministry and service opportunities for families

The youth minister will assist the Pastor in the daily issues of church ministry which include but are not limited to: the rotation of call, visitation of hospitals, visitation of membership, guests and prospects and preaching when needed. The youth minister shall model maturity for the students. His appearance, attitude, behavior, language, etc., should portray what the Lord wants from each of the students as he/she grows to become church and community leaders.
